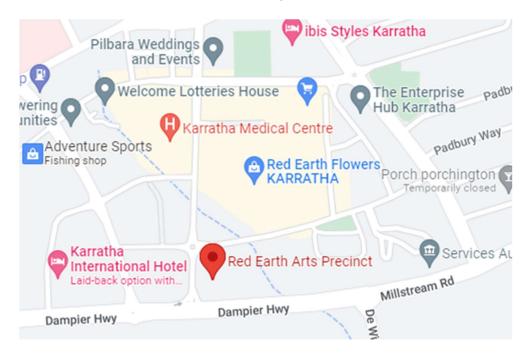

- 2. A duly appointed Proxy must be a registered Member of the PKKP Aboriginal Corporation.
- 3. To be effective the Proxy Form prescribed by The PKKP Aboriginal Corporation must be completed fully and signed personally by the Member and received by the PKKP Aboriginal Corporation at least 48 hours before the time appointed for the holding of this Annual General Meeting, that is by 10:00 am on the 15th of November 2022.
- 4. If the proxy form specifies a way in which the proxy is to vote on any of the resolutions stated above, then the proxy need not vote on a show of hands, but if the proxy does so, the proxy must vote that way; and
- 5. A Proxy's authority to speak and vote for a Member at a meeting is suspended if the Member who provides the Proxy actually attends the same meeting.

CORPORATION CRITERIA FOR DIRECTOR APPOINTMENT

Directors of the Corporation are required and will be supported to undertake ongoing Board training to meet the Corporation's required governance criteria.

- Directors are required to meet certain legal duties and responsibilities.
- The corporation's Rule Book governs the powers and functions of Directors.
- Directors should at all times employ a reasonable degree of skill, care and diligence in the exercise of their powers and the discharge of their duties.
- In practice this means:
 - Understanding the role of being a Director;
 - Knowing the law in respect of directorship;
 - Attending and actively participate in Board meetings; and
 - Read all Board papers and reports.

AS A DIRECTOR YOU MUST

- Attend all Board meetings and other convened meetings as required;
- Read your Board papers and be prepared for each Board meeting;
- Participate actively in all Board meetings;
- Stay up to date on what the corporation is doing;
- Ensure compliance with the Rule Book and CATSI Act;
- Sit on your Language Group Land Committee;
- Actively manage or direct the management of the business of the Corporation;
- Be available for your community;
- Act in good faith and with a duty of care (see page 2);
- Disclose material personal interests or conflicts relating to the affairs of the Corporation;



- Ensure that the money of the Corporation is sufficient to make all payments as required and that the money is being properly managed;
- Be prepared to take on further training and Board education programs.

ACTING IN GOOD FAITH AND WITH A DUTY OF CARE

- A Director must be seen to be making decisions in the best interests of the whole corporation, not of groups of owners/stakeholders or individuals.
- The Director must not make improper use of information to obtain, indirectly or directly, a gain or advantage for the Director or any other person, or to cause a detriment to the corporation.
- A Director's position must only be used for the corporation's interests. If a Director has a personal interest that might give rise to a conflict of interest, that Director must disclose the interest at the Directors' Board meetings.
- Your duty as a Director is to look after the welfare of the corporation as a whole.
- Where a Director has, or is seen to have, personal interests that compete with the interests of the corporation, The Board may require a Director to leave the room should they resolve that that Director has a conflict of interest in the matter and should therefore not participate in the decision making process.
- In the event that a Director misses three (3) Board meetings in a row without a genuine reason the Board may remove that Director from the Board and replace them with another representative from their group.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The PKKP Board has a Code of Conduct which govern behaviours for all Directors attending meetings. This ensures that all Board meetings are conducted professionally and that all the business of the Corporation can be dealt with in the time that is allocated to the meetings.
