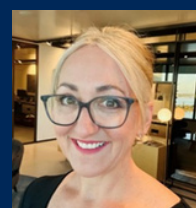

What's New in the 2026–27 PKKP Member Benefits Guidelines?

The PKKP Trusts have introduced increased funding across several key benefit areas to provide greater support for members and families in the coming financial year. The two most significant changes are increases to the Direct Benefits Trust (DBT) allocations and the Groceries Fund under the Charitable Trust.



Increased Direct Benefits Trust (DBT) Allocations

All age groups will receive an additional \$5,000 in annual DBT benefits, with increases reflected in the cash allocation available to members. Examples include:

- Ages 18–24: \$25,000
- Ages 25–39: \$35,000
- Ages 40–49: \$45,000
- Ages 50+: \$55,000



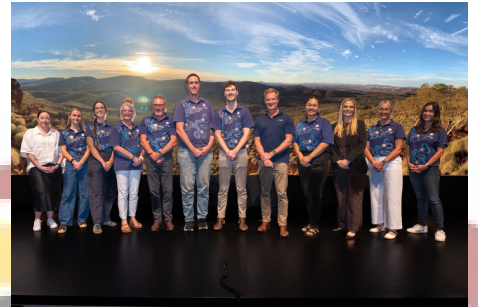
Increased Groceries Fund

The Charitable Trust Groceries Fund has also received a substantial increase. The annual benefit has increased from \$7,200 to \$12,000, with monthly support increasing from \$600 per month to **\$1,000** per month for eligible members.

These enhancements reflect the ongoing commitment of the Trustee and DMC to ensure Trust benefits continue to support the wellbeing of PKKP members and families, particularly in response to increasing living costs and community needs. Members are encouraged to review the updated Member Benefits Guidelines and contact the Executive Office if they have any questions about their eligibility or available benefits.
