People are wandering out yonder and exploring the natural beauty of our great state.

While we're enjoying WA's natural beauty, visiting attractions and meeting new people, it's important that we look after each other.

There are more than 200 remote Aboriginal communities in Western Australia, across the Midwest, Gascoyne, Pilbara, Goldfields and Kimberley regions.

The residents of these communities are more vulnerable to COVID-19 than other Western Australians.

To help keep remote Aboriginal communities safe from COVID-19, there are strict travel restrictions in place. Tourists and travellers are not allowed to enter.

Some remote Aboriginal communities have applied for exclusions from the travel restrictions and they, or their amenities, are [open to visitors](#).

[Planning your trip](#) well in advance will help you navigate remote areas and avoid entering [restricted areas](#).

PLC Indigenous Scholarship Application 2023

Indigenous Scholarships are offered to students entering Year 7 in 2022

Eligibility: Students must identify as an Indigenous Australian and priority will be given to those who come from isolated areas.

Prospective students should have sufficient self-confidence and personal support to enter a new school at Year 7 with the intention of continuing to Year 12.

Students must be eligible for Abstudy to apply.

Selection Criteria

Academic levels and achievements of a student are considered but are not the predominant criteria for selection. Selection is based on consideration of the following criteria:

1. Academic – Students should demonstrate • sufficient study skills to cope with the demands of the curriculum; • good work habits (e.g. completing homework, preparedness to tackle new work); • interest in learning; and • reasonable literacy and numeracy levels for age level.
2. Talent – Applicants may demonstrate outstanding talent in a particular field of endeavor such as in sport, art, dance, music, drama, leadership, etc.
3. Commitment – Students must demonstrate a preparedness to commit to stay at the School until the completion of Year 12.
4. Attitude – Students must demonstrate a positive attitude to learning, be able to adjust to and respond positively to the School environment and have the social skills and confidence to relate well with others.

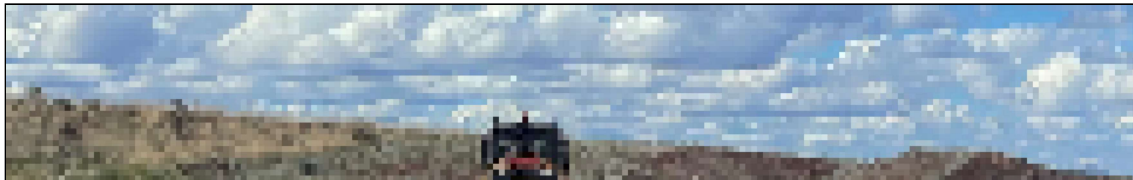


Photo of the IMC PKKPE JV Grader commencing RMT remediation works near the FMG Train Load Out.

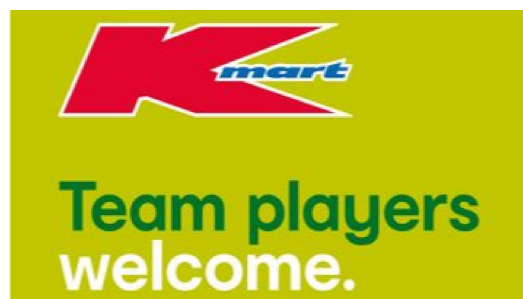
