There are more than 200 remote Aboriginal communities in Western Australia, across the Midwest, Gascoyne, Pilbara, Goldfields and Kimberley regions.

The residents of these communities are more vulnerable to COVID-19 than other

Western Australians

To help keep remote Aboriginal communities safe from COVID-19, there are strict travel restrictions in place. Tourists and travellers are not allowed to enter.

Some remote Aboriginal communities have applied for exclusions from the travel restrictions and they, or their amenities, are <u>open to visitors</u>.

<u>Planning your trip</u> well in advance will help you navigate remote areas and avoid entering <u>restricted areas</u>.







Indigenous Scholarships are offered to students entering Year 7 in 2022 Eligibility: Students must identify as an Indigenous Australian and priority will be

Prospective students should have sufficient self-confidence and personal support to enter a new school at Year 7 with the intention of continuing to Year 12.

Students must be eligible for Abstudy to apply.

### Selection Criteria

Academic levels and achievements of a student are considered but are not the predominant criteria for selection. Selection is based on consideration of the following criteria:






